

CORA HARTSHORN ARBORETUM



The Cora Hartshorn Arboretum consists of approximately 16.5 acres of woodlands bequeathed to Millburn Township by Cora L. Hartshorn in 1958. There are roughly 3 miles of trails throughout the Arboretum and the terrain is hilly in many places. Benches are located throughout the Arboretum grounds.

Restoration of the Arboretum's woodlands began in 2002. We ask your help with our efforts to restore the woodlands to a healthy forest ecosystem. Please walk only on the trails, do not litter and close all fence gates behind you. The picking of wildflowers and other plants is prohibited.

In accordance with Millburn Township ordinances, no dogs are permitted on Arboretum grounds.
